KEYS & REMOTES

Thank you for purchasing a MAP product. Please see below instructions on how to program your replacement garage door remote to your garage door motor.

KF921 Replaces unit pictured below



MT SERIES

1. Select the button on the KF921 you wish to use to open the garage door.
2. Press and hold the selected button on your KF921.
3. Press and release the orange 'Learn' button on the garage door motor.
4. The garage motors light will either flash or, if no lights fitted, two clicks will be heard indicating the KF921 has been coded.

MR SERIES

1. Select the button on the KF921 you wish to use to open the garage door.
2. Press and hold the selected button on the KF921. The orange LED will flash.
3. Press and release the purple 'Learn' Button on the garage door opener panel. The opener panels courtesy LED's will flash once. Release the remotes push button.

TO DELETE ALL REMOTES CODED TO THE MOTOR:

1. Press and hold the 'Learn' button on the opener panel until the light turns off (approx. 6-10 seconds)
2. Now test by pressing a button on a previously coded transmitter – The motor should not respond
