Thank you for purchasing a MAP product. Please see below instructions on how to program your replacement garage door remote to your garage door motor.

Programming the KF930 to your garage door motor:

1. Carefully remove cover from the control box by lifting the tab at the bottom.
2. Press the receiver button once (located on the receiver board, in the top left corner of the control box) and the red light will illuminate.
3. Press button 1 on the new remote for 2 seconds. Press the KF930 button to test the operation of the door or gate etc.

To delete all the transmitters coded into the garage door motor:

1. Press and hold the receiver button for 12 seconds.
2. Press the transmitter button to test that the transmitter no longer works. The motor should remain unresponsive.

Note: When programming remote to multiple doors, you must always program in using button 1 on the new remote control. Once the new remote is programmed to the door, it will automatically assign the appropriate button to the door.

WARNING! This remote contains a button/coin cell battery. If swallowed, a lithium battery can cause severe or fatal injuries within 2 hours or less. Keep batteries out of reach of children at all times whether they are new or used.
